The ICB (Integrated Care Board) have been working on a **cholesterol campaign** which aims to encourage adults aged 40 or over, or those with a family history of high cholesterol, and have not had a cholesterol check before or in the past 5 years, to get a check by contacting their GP surgery. If this applies to you, please do make an appointment to get your cholesterol checked.

Your **mental health** is also important and there are various ways in which you can access help. Please note you can **ring 111** and **choose option 2** to start the triaging process. Incidentally, just to give our farming families the heads up, we are going to be contacting you once more in the near future because Pinfold is now piloting a scheme regarding mental health within the farming community. This is to test services before being rolled out to the wider region.
